PS Medway Queen was built by the Ailsa Shipbuilding Company of Troon, Scotland, and launched on St. George's Day (23rd April) 1924. She sailed under the flag of the New Medway Steam Packet Company which was taken over by General Steam Navigation

in 1937. These wagons are produced in cooperation with the General Steam Navigation Locomotive Restoration Society, based at Blunsdon, and the Medway Queen Preservation Society, based on Gillingham Pier.
